Face and Neck Lift Patient Instructions

• Before surgery:

- Please do not take aspirin, naproxen, ibuprofen, vitamin E, flax seed oil, fish oil, or ANY herbal supplements for 3 weeks prior and 3 weeks after surgery.
- Take a shower the morning of your surgery. Do not wear any makeup or product in your hair. Wear a button-down top and comfortable pants.
- You will need a driver after surgery and someone to stay the night with you

• Immediately after surgery:

- You will go home with a soft, snug dressing around your head.
 Keep this dry and in place.
- o Expect to experience mild swelling, bruising, and tightness.
- Use an ice pack for the first 48 hrs (20 minutes every waking hour). Cold packs, crushed ice, or frozen peas in a ziplock bag all work well.
- Start with a soft diet when you get home and proceed to a regular diet as tightness improves. Drink plenty of fluids.
- Get plenty of rest. Sleep with your head elevated for at least the first 72 hours. 2 to 3 pillows are usually sufficient or a recliner also works well.
- You may resume non-strenuous activities around the house after 24 hours. Avoid straining or bending down.
- Take prescription pain medication and antibiotics as ordered.
 You may transition to Tylenol.
- Do not smoke and avoid drinking alcohol as these will impair healing.

- If you develop excessive swelling particularly if accompanied by extreme bruising and pain, especially on one side, call our office immediately.
- Your dressings will be removed and replaced with a lighter dressing after 1-2 days at your first post-op visit. You may wish to come to the visit wearing a scarf or hood to cover the dressings.

After dressings are removed:

- Gently clean incisons twice daily with hydrogen peroxide soaked q-tips to prevent scabs from forming. Use a rolling motion. After cleaning, apply **bacitracin** ointment. Continue wound care until sutures and clips are removed.
- o You may shower and gently wash your face.
- You may wash your hair with a gentle shampoo after 3 days. Do not blow dry your hair.
- Swelling will peak at 48-72 hrs after surgery and then will begin to subside
- Sutures and clips will be removed at one week.

After sutures are removed:

- o You may begin to wear makeup
- o You may begin to use a moisturizer on your face
- You may use a hair dryer but use caution
- o Do not wear earrings for 2-3 weeks
- o Bruising and obvious swelling may last 1-2 weeks
- Expect to have mild tightness, firmness, crusting, and itching along the incisions for the next 3-4 weeks of healing. You will experience periods of pulling and tightening as the swelling decreases and healing begins. Areas of numbness are also normal, sensation will return with time.
- You may color your hair in 3-4 weeks
- You may resume light exercise after 2 weeks and strenuous activity after 6 weeks
- o Avoid direct sun exposure for 6-8 weeks
- Incisions will fade to barely visible lines over the next 2-3 months
- o It may take as long as 6 months for the temporary numbness around the ears to resolve
